



## The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Unspoken : Survivors Stories PROSPECTUS

**Exhibition Dates:** September 1-September 30, 2022

**Location:** Virtual

This exhibit will be available virtually on the Arizona Art Alliance, Arizona Artists Guild and Your Art Your Story websites.

**Overview:** The 3rd Annual Unspoken : Survivors Stories features artwork by visual artists affected by suicide to raise awareness of the impact of suicide. The exhibit is co-sponsored by exhibition partners Your Art Your Story, the Arizona Art Alliance, and the Arizona Artists Guild. This show will feature original two- and three-dimensional works including painting, drawing, photography, digital art, collage and sculpture. There are no fees to enter this show. Up to three works may be entered.

**Important Dates:**

**August 28, 2022:** Entries are accepted through the Arizona Art Alliance website.

**Who is Eligible to Enter?** This exhibit is open to anyone throughout the world whose life has been affected by suicide loss or attempt, and people who work/volunteer in the field.

**How to Enter:**

- Original two-dimensional and three-dimensional artwork including painting, drawing, photography, digital art, collage and sculpture may be submitted. Giclee prints are not allowed.
- Up to 3 works of art may be entered by each person.
- Be sure to completely fill out the entry form.

You will need to include the following:

your name as you would like it to appear online,

the title, medium, dimensions and price of your work (if your work is for sale) or NFS (if it is Not for Sale).  
Phone number, email address, social media links, website address if you have one.

- Take photos of your work and crop the images to remove the background and/or frame.
- Image file size should not exceed 5MB in size or 6 inches on the longest side.
- Identify your image files with your last name, a space, the title Examples: DaVinci Mona Lisa, Van Gogh Starry Night
- No substitute or additional images will be accepted after completing the entry process.
- Please do not enter works that were already shown in previous Unspoken : Survivors Stories exhibitions.
