Phoenix Airport Museum is presenting the exhibition

Night Vision

October 21, 2023 – May 26, 2024

Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport, Terminal 4, Level 3 display, eight cases

Have your art on display in one of the country's busiest airports!

To the Artist: Phoenix Airport Museum (**PAM**) is seeking artworks that exemplifies the nighttime. Rich in mystery and symbolic potential, the nighttime has long inspired artists to consider darkness, the cosmos and the unknown. The night is not only a moment in time but can also be a place of solitude, tranquility and dreaming. From the glow of moonlight in the desert to nocturnal creatures to city lights there's plenty of inspiration for artists.

There is no fee to apply. Accepted artworks will be chosen by the Phoenix Airport Museum's curatorial staff.

Eligibility: Artists residing in Arizona may submit a **maximum of four artworks** for consideration. Original, two and three-dimensional artworks in **all media** and **styles** may be entered **except giclées of paintings and canvas-wrapped prints**. Artwork must be able to fit in display cases which are 10 feet high by 15 feet wide and 20 inches deep.

How to Enter: Submissions must be received by **5pm, Friday, July 21, 2023**, and include the following:

- **Contact information** including name, address, phone number and email address.
- **PDF image list** of artworks with descriptions, materials and dimensions of artwork **and** frame (given as height x width.)
- **Images:** One of each submitted artwork plus one optional detail of each artwork. Images must be submitted through <https://wettransfer.com> (see next page for instructions), 300 dpi and sized approximately 4 x 6". The artist's last name and artwork title should be in the file name. **Example:** Smith.SunriseOverPhoenix.jpg

Transportation: Artists are responsible for transportation of work to **PAM**. Artworks may be hand-delivered to the Museum's off-site facility or shipped. If artwork is hand-delivered, artist is responsible for delivery and pick up. If artwork is shipped, cost of shipping is the artist's responsibility and **PAM** will pay for return shipping via FedEx unless otherwise arranged by the artist at time of acceptance. Work being shipped must be packed in a re-usable shipping container. Artists are responsible for checking with their shipper regarding insurance and correct packing procedures. **PAM** will not be responsible for breakage because of incorrect packing or an insufficient container. Artists will be notified when their work arrives and of its condition.

Liability: Insurance will be carried by the City of Phoenix on all works while in possession of **PAM**.

Agreement: Accepted artworks must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition. Submission of an entry constitutes permission to photograph work for publicity and educational purposes. All entries must be of original design and personal execution. **PAM** reserves the right to refuse an entry if upon arrival, the artwork is found to be poorly executed or inappropriate for public display.

Instructions for submitting through WeTransfer

- Visit <https://wetransfer.com>. You do not need to create an account.
- “Email to” airport.museum@phoenix.gov
- “Your email” enter your email.
- “Title” must include the artist’s full name followed by “artwork entry” (example: John Doe_artwork entry).
- “Message” must include the artist’s full name, mailing address, phone number and email address (example: John Doe, 111 W. Elm Street, Phoenix, AZ 85006, 480-888-8787, john.doe@gmail.com)
Select the option “send email transfer”
- Upload the application materials in one transfer including the PDF image list and images of the artwork.
- Click the “Transfer” button. A verification code will be sent to your email. If you do not enter the verification code within 60 minutes you will need to start over.

Once the entry is submitted, you should receive a confirmation email from WeTransfer.

You will receive an email confirming your application materials from airport.museum@phoenix.gov up to one week after submitting.
